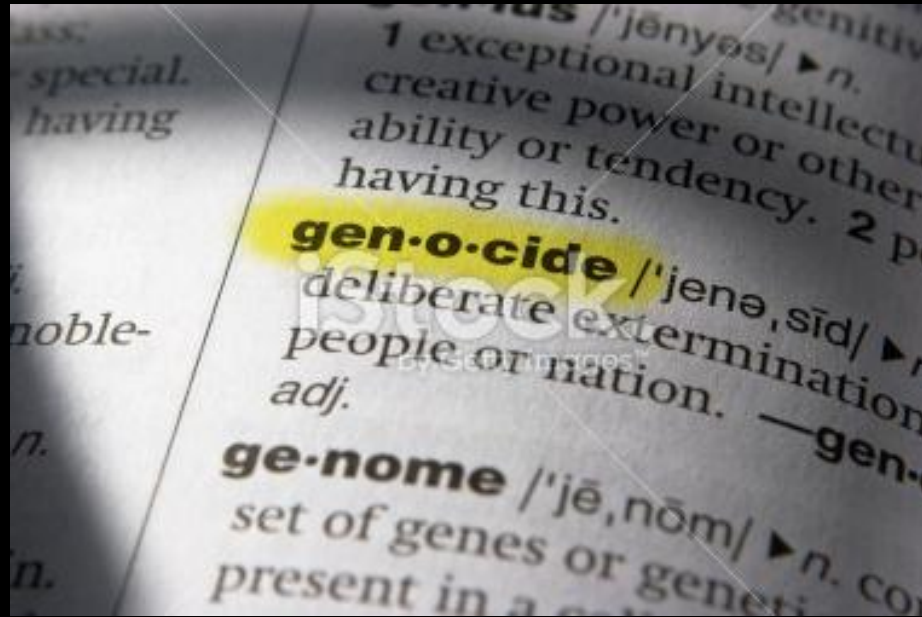


The Holocaust-

GENOCIDE: the deliberate killing of a large group of people, especially those of a particular ethnic group or nation.
synonyms: mass murder, mass homicide, massacre



The Death Toll

Between five and six million Jews

More than three million Soviet prisoners of war

More than two million Soviet civilians

More than one million Polish civilians

More than one million Yugoslav civilians

About 70,000 men, women and children with mental and physical handicaps

More than 200,000 gipsies

Unknown numbers of political prisoners, fighters, and others...

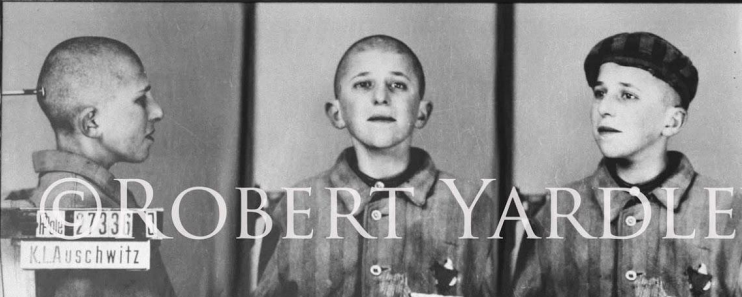
